



People's Declaration for the Sustainable Future of Planet Earth

a summary

1. 1.5°C must be implemented and strictly enforced.
 2. Developed countries should provide financial and technological support to developing countries. National government should safeguard the livelihoods of all segments of society, particularly disadvantaged groups.
 3. Powerful countries and large corporations have disproportionate influence over global climate decision-making. The voices of the most affected people and areas have to be prioritised in climate decision-making.
 4. All people have a right to a clean environment. This right should be included in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and be strictly enforced at the international level.
 5. Ecocide must be codified as a crime in international and national laws, applicable to governments and corporations. It has to be firmly enforced alongside existing environmental protection laws.

Global Assembly is a governance body made up of citizens who are representative of the world population by gender, age, education, geography and views on climate. The Core Assembly Members are selected through a global lottery process known as sortition, meaning that **anyone on earth can be selected**. People can also participate through running a Community Assembly, meaning that **anyone on earth can participate**.

In 2021 the Global Assembly has been answering the question: "How can humanity address the climate and ecological crisis in a fair and effective way?" The declaration is the result of these deliberations and has been prepared for COP26.
